

BOOM CLEAN

MATERIAL & FUNCTION

BOOM CLEAN is a blend of alkaline salts, ammonia, phosphates, metasilicates and non ionic surfactants to form a complete detergent to clean and assist in the flushing out of pesticides and herbicides from all agricultural spraying equipment.

BOOM CLEAN HAS MANY ADVANTAGES:-

- (a) Dissolves Residues,
- (b) Prevents Corrosion
- (c) Safe to use on all metals and plastic parts.
- (d) Lubricates pumps.
- (e) Cleans and disinfects.
- (f) Low foaming.

APPLICATION

BOOM CLEAN IS VERY ECONOMICAL TO USE:

- (a) For cleaning Boom Sprays Dilute 1 litre of Boom Klen to 100 litres of water and flush 10 litres of this mixture through each nozzle.
- (b) Knapsacks - Mix 50 ml Boom Klen to 5 litres of water and flush through.
- (c) Aircraft - Mix 2.5 litres Boom Klen per 50 litres of water and flush through.
- (d) Orchard Sprays - Mix 3 litres Boom Klen per 100 litres of water and flush through system.

The addition of "Sodium Hypochlorite 12 1/2%" (approximately 2 litres to 100 litre mixture) may be required to assist in the removal of some sprays that are currently being used in the wheat belt areas.

CAUTION

BOOM CLEAN Contains caustic. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact flush immediately with water.

FIRST AID

If poisoning occurs, contact a doctor. If swallowed do not induce vomiting, give a glass of water. If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly.
