SPICE AIR

DISINFECTANT

MATERIAL & FUNCTION

SPICE AIR is a powerful quaternary disinfectant with outstanding detergent/cleaning properties. It is designed to clean all types of surfaces and then leave surface fully sanitized. The pleasant spice air fragrance is strongly residual and will leave the surface smelling fresh and clean.

APPEARANCE: **SPICE AIR** is a thin blue liquid with a strong spicy fragrance.

APPLICATION

SPICE AIR finds application both commercially and domestically for the sanitation and cleaning of bathroom, washroom, toilet and ablution areas. **SPICE AIR** is also suitable in kitchen areas. In commercial food processing operations, sanitizing should be achieved using **QUAT CLEAN**, **PROXITAINE** or **SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE**.

Dilute **SPICE AIR** at 1:25 TO 1:100 with water. To ensure a complete sanitation ensure a contact time of at least 5 minutes. In dirty conditions use **SPICE AIR** diluted to 3 parts water and ensure contact time of 5 minutes.

For cleaning without sanitation dilute **SPICE AIR** 1:200 with warm water. For ablution areas, toilet bowls and urinals use **SPICE AIR** at full strength to get a lingering spicy air fragrance.

FIRST AID

If poisoning occurs contact a doctor or Poisons Information Centre. If swallowed give Ipecac syrup to induce vomiting. If in eyes, hold eyes open, flood with water for at least 15 minutes and see a doctor.

PACKAGING

750 mL, 5, 15 & 200 Litre containers.
